

Diversity Data

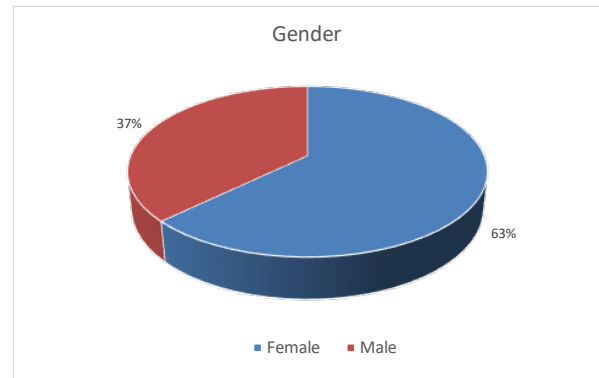
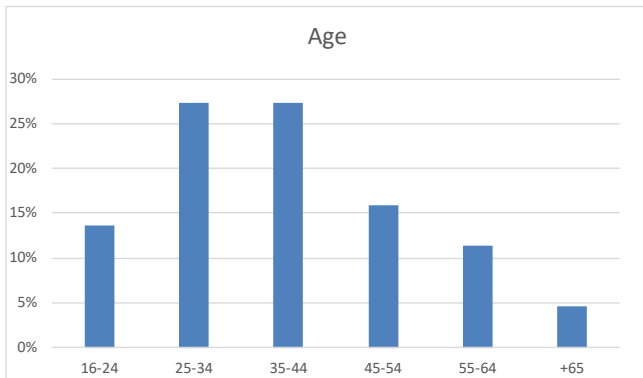
This report is compiled and published in compliance of the Bar Standards Board (BSB) regulation which requires Chambers to gather and publish the diversity data of Chambers' members. This survey was conducted in the last quarter of 2023 and will next be updated in 2026.

The survey was voluntary and was conducted in such a way to guarantee the respondent's anonymity so data is not published where its publication might reasonably lead to the identification of individuals unless specific authorisation has been granted.

The Data Diversity Policy and the BSB requirements provide that data will not be published where fewer than ten individuals within a particular category have the same relevant characteristics. Our KC, Pupil and staff groups have 10 or fewer members respectively, so to maintain anonymity, they are combined into a Chambers wide group.

Data is summarised based on responses actually received and may not reflect the position that would have applied if all those eligible to participate had chosen to do so. Categories without any positive responses do not appear in the graphs for ease of legibility.

Where further clarity is needed, the questions and/or the narrative to the questions have been added.



This following question is designed to gather trans data i.e. whether your gender identity and/or gender expression differs from your birth sex. A transperson may or may not seek to undergo gender reassignment / hormonal treatment/ surgery.
